## **EASY ZIPPERED BOX POUCH**

## **Supplies Needed**:

Two different colored fabrics

Outside Fabric: two each 13 inches by 9  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches rectangle two each 13 inches by 9  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches rectangle

one strip 2 1/4 inch by 7 inch for pull tab

Fusible fleece: two each 13 inches by 9 ½ inches

One 14-inch zipper

Sewing thread, straight pins, and clover clips




Place fusible fleece on ironing board with bumpy side up.


Place outside fabric on top of fleece face up.



Press to fuse fleece to fabric.

Repeat so both pieces are fused.





Take the 2 1/4 inch by 7 inch strip and fold in half lengthwise. Press. Fold 1/4 inch on each side and press. Top stitch on both sides. Cut into two pieces. (or you can make a tube and then top stitch as above) Fold bag in half from the zipper, with the outside fabric inside and lining Line up the bottom of the bag. Sew bottom of the bag together with ½ inch seam allowance. Zig zag the seam to finish the bottom Trim up both sides of the bag. Open up the zipper. Line up bottom seam with zipper. Fold the pull tab pieces in half and place one at each end of the zipper and

Fold the pull tab pieces in half and place one at each end of the zipper and pin in place, sandwich all layers together.

Use care on the open end of the zipper to pin both sides in place prior to stitching.
