EDUCATIONAL TIDBIT - Mona Bonbright

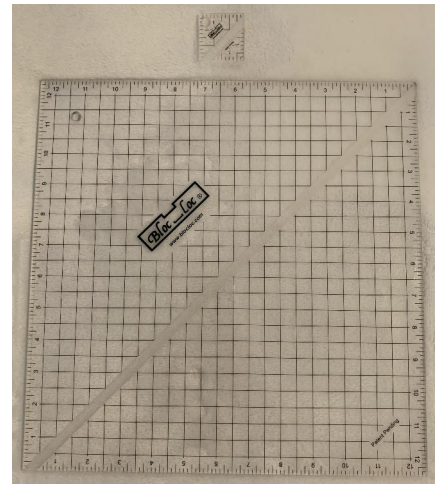
Avoid the Temptation to Use Tiny Templates to Cut Fabric

Happy September 2022! I hope you all had a nice summer. I am so happy to share another Educational Tidbit with you.

One of my favorite blocks is a square made in the half square triangle (HST) configuration. HSTs are easy to make and can be used in so many different ways.

The one thing that I really struggled with, when I first started making HSTs, was keeping the HST straight when I attempted to square it to the correct size. The diagonal seam always seemed to make this lump that made my template wobble and wiggle. My resultant trimmed HSTs were not always the accurately cut squares I desired.

Then, I discovered the wonderful acrylic templates made especially for measuring and cutting HSTs called “Bloc-Loc”. I was so enthralled with these templates that I decided to procure every size I could find to trim up the perfect HST. As shown in the picture below, the smallest one in my inventory measures 1 ½ inch square and the largest is 12 ½ inch square.

A total of **240 quilts** have been donated to various OC organizations so far in 2022. With the enthusiastic participation of quilters and sewers in of Clubhouse 4, we are well on our way to completing 200 pillowcases for OC foster kids at the CASA Christmas Party. **Great job, quilters and sewers!**

We could use your help completing **Cuddle Quilts for the OC foster kids** at CASA Christmas Party. Cuddle Quilts are made the same way that Chemo Quilts are made with a cotton top and fleece back measuring approximately 40x60. These take very little time to assemble, as most tops are large panels

with borders or just a few strips or very large blocks. The completed tops are sewn right sides together with fleece backing (held taut), then turned right side out and stitched ½” from the edge. will provide longarm quilting for these quilts if desired.

Pillowcase and Cuddle Quilt **kits are available** for pickup from a bin on the table nearest the parking lot entry of the Quilt Room of CH4. Ruth Naomi has made several cuddle quilts and has mastered the process. Tips and photos of Ruth’s process will be posted on the Guild’s website.

BONANZA, November 5-6, 2023, Clubhouse 4

You must sign up for at least one two-hour shift to sell. Inventory lists, price tags and signup sheets will be available at the September and October meetings and will be posted on the website and printed at home.

2022 BONANZA SELLER INSTRUCTIONS

Intake Thursday, November 3, 10 am - Noon

Setup Friday, November 4, 9 am - 1 pm

Bonanza Saturday, November 5, 9 am - 4 pm

Bonanza Sunday, November 6, 10 am – 3 pm

Unsold Item Pickup, Sunday, November 6, 3:30-4 pm

1. Sign up on **Volunteer Sign-up List**. All Sellers are required to volunteer to help in the studio for **at least one 2-hour shift** on **Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday**. The jobs include intake, set-up, product staging, cashiering, door management, item return, etc.
2. Sign up on **Seller Sign-up List** to receive your forms and your **Seller #** to use on all forms.
3. Complete the **Seller Inventory List** listing EVERY ITEM you wish to sell as an individual line item to make sales calculations accurate. Dittos are acceptable for duplicate items. The **Seller Inventory List** must accompany your items when you bring them to the studio on Intake Day.
4. Complete a **Seller Sales Ticket** for EVERY ITEM you wish to sell, regardless of size, and attach it with a Safety Pin to the **BOTTOM RIGHT** of each item. Every Seller Sales Ticket **MUST** at least have your **Seller Number** and a **Price** on it. The Club will provide safety pins if needed.
5. **Intake Day is Thursday, Nov. 3, between 10 am and 12 pm**. Each item will be checked off your **Seller Inventory List** so there are no issues or missing items on Sunday afternoon. If you are donating all of the proceeds of your sales to the Club, list your **Name** as **Donation** and **Seller Number** as **0** on the Seller Inventory List.
6. **Unsold Item Pickup** will be **Sunday, November 6 between 3:30 and 4 pm**. Just like the check-in process, we will check off every item returned on your Seller Inventory List to guarantee payment for you are paid for sold items and you receive unsold items. **The Room will be closed at 4pm**.
7. Sales totals will be calculated by the Treasurer after BONANZA and checks will be available for pickup in the quilting room on the following Thursday.
8. Unlike other LWV clubs, there is no \$20 per table cost to you individually. The Guild covers the table cost to GRF. You will, however, incur a 15% deduction from your sales total which goes to the Guild to cover the costs to GRF, credit card processing fees, and other monies spent to hold the event, as well as a donation to your favorite guild!
9. Donna Karbach is our Bonanza Chair this year, so please feel to reach out to her with any questions and concerns. She will be your point of contact going forward. Her email is dkarbach2000@gmail.com and phone number 650-278-1949.
10. Finally, tell all your friends to come visit us at BONANZA on Saturday, November 5 between 9am and 3pm or Sunday, November 6, between 10 and 4.
