## **LONGARM QUILTING MACHINE**



It Has Arrived! We spent Friday, April 7th at Clubhouse 4 getting the longarm delivered and set up. We are waiting for a couple of parts to be delivered so we can do any size quilt up to about 84 inches wide, but it can be used for small quilts and training as is. We will be setting up a Training and Certification Program which all users will have to complete prior to use. There will also be procedures for reserving and using the machine, and for reimbursement for supplies (thread, needles, etc.). Supervisors will be trained first since they will have to be on the premises whenever the machine is used. Then members will be trained. All potential users will have to become members so they can be

trained. We already have one new member because she wants to learn to use the longarm. Look for more information in next month's newsletter!
