## EDUCATIONAL TIDBIT – Mona Bonbright October 2023 How to store strips after you cut them

When I am sewing a quilt top, there always seems to be lots of long strips involved. In addition

to using jelly roll strips, I must cut border strips, sashing strips, and binding strips. After cutting or unfurling a jelly roll, I like to press strips before using them in the quilt. Once strips are pressed, if I am not ready to sew them into the quilt, where can I put those strips until I am ready? I used to lay them across the sofa or hang them on clothes hangers or drape them across my lights by the sewing machine. These options really did not work well to keep the strips out of the way until I was ready to sew them into the quilt and most times, they got wrinkled again and I had to re-press them.
